Please do not let them stay in bed or have too much free time because we want their habits for learning to stay strong so that when this is over they can return easily to typical school routines. We all know that September is hard after a six-week holiday and this potentially could be as long or longer.

Teachers have created home learning packs which have been sent home today. In addition, the website has a list of suitable websites children may use to aid learning. I have asked teachers to keep in touch with their classes daily via Twitter and Marvellous Me and they will add extra ideas and activities as and when.

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School Meals: Our catering staff will provide packed lunches for all children who receive a free school
