Activity	Helpful tips
Maths Create and complete 6 division calculations where you have to divide by a 1-digit number e.g. $845 \div 4 =$	Remember to carry any remainders to the next column.
Writing Five common subordinating conjunctions are <i>because, so that, after, though</i> and <i>while</i> . Can you write sentences that use these conjunctions?	Subordinating conjunctions add extra information e.g. <i>I sang along to the radio <u>while</u> making breakfast.</i>
Reading Focus on a book you are currently reading. Can you find a character description? Use your retrieval skills to draw a picture of that character.	Try listing the descriptors first before starting to draw.
Art There are lots of plants springing up. Can you sketch an interesting new plant you have in the garden or have seen on a walk?	Use shading to add tone to your sketch.
PE Choose a fitness activity e.g. skipping, star jumps or burpies. How many can you do in 1 minute? Try and beat your score each day this week.	Don't forget to record your daily total.
