Activity	Helpful tips
PE- Throwing and catching Using a ball, practice your throwing and catching skills. Focus on push pass, bounce pass and shoulder pass. Think back to our PE lessons	Aim your throw towards your partner's chest. Don't aim too high or too low.
Science experiment- Does light effect the colour of an object? Grab 3 packets in your home eg empty crisps/chocolate/sweet wrapper. Put one on a window ledge, one in a dark place and one in your front room.	This experiment is over a week. You will need to record your results after a week. You may want to

<p>Design and Technology- Create your own fairground ride. Remember our Dt topic at the start of the year? Your task is to create your own fairground ride which has a pulley system (think of a blind in your house). Label your drawing.</p>	<p>Think about which rides go up and down at a fairground.</p>
<p>Science- Healthy eating Think about what food your body needs to stay fit and healthy. Create a healthy snack which would help an athlete. Think about how much activity they do and what the food would need to include to keep the athlete fit.</p>	<p>Discuss what a healthy diet means with an adult at home. Get an understanding of what is inside foods to make them healthy.</p>
<p>English- persuasive writing Write a letter to the Government to persuade them to stop school children from having to wear uniform. What are the benefits behind this? Why do children not want to wear their uniform? Would it help them concentrate in lesson?</p>	<p>Make a pro/cons list before writing to help you write your persuasive piece.</p>
