Activity	Where to find it	Helpful tips
Maths task Ordering numbers within 50. Have a go at this lesson. Watch the video and remember when we did this in class just before we closed. The video might jog your memory. Reading Task Choose another book from Oxford owl and read it out loud to an adult. Discuss the story and what happens. Can you retell the story orally in the correct order? Do the activities that go with the book and then you could draw your favourite part of the story.	https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/	You will need a pencil and paper. It may help to make notes as you read.

Phonics Task Phonics Try the new daily phonics lessons on YouTube. 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Non-Screen Activities	
Activity	Helpful tips
<u>Physical Task</u> For this activity you will need someone to work with. Set up a 'goal' area and take it in turns with your partner to defend the area while the other person tries to dodge the defender and get through.	Use cushions, cones, chairs to make you goal area if you don't have a real goal.
<u>Science Task</u> Find out about seasonal plants – which plants grow in the Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter? Make an information poster to display your findings. Can you include some moving parts into your poster?	You will need: pencil, crayons, paper, scissors and glue.
<u>Writing Task</u> Can you write a nature poem using your senses? What can you hear, see, feel, smell in your garden? Remember poems don't have to rhyme!	You will need: pencil, paper.
<u>Maths Task</u> Quarter – Numbers (Practical) Find quarter of quantities (multiples of 4 only) by sharing small objects such as pasta, pegs or counters into 4 equal groups. Use the stem sentence: Quarter of ___ is ___ Eg, Quarter of 20 is 5	You will need: pegs, lego, sweets, pencil, paper.
<u>Reading task</u> Choose your favourite book and read it to an adult. Discuss why you like this book and what happens in the story. Can you write a book review explaining your favourite character, favourite part and what might happen next?	You will need: book, pencil, paper, crayons. Remember our book of the month and the tasks we do then to help you with your ideas.
