OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

In **Science**, we will start our learning looking at different types of plants and trees. Exploring wild and garden plants and evergreen and deciduous trees.

During **Geography**, we will be learning about the United Kingdom and the different countries that make it up. We will also learn about the different seas which surround it.
