### OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

**We have lots of learning to look forward to across KS1!**

In **Science**, we will be investigating what animals need to survive and looking at what carnivores, herbivores and omnivores eat.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at how to take care of things, including some learning about basic first aid.
