OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

LKS2

Geography: The children are learning skills and fieldwork through the theme of Our Community.

Science: The children are exploring magnets.

RE: The children are finding out Who is Jewish and what do they believe?

PSHE: In Me and My Relationships, the children are learning about how to work and play well together.

Art: The children are creating papier mâché sculptures.

Music: The children are learning about writing down music.

PE: In gymnastics, the children are developing their balance, strength and coordination.

Computing: The children are learning about internet safety through What do you say? and are also exploring Connecting Computers.

Spanish: The children are practising Spanish greetings.

UKS2

Geography: The children are developing their location and fieldwork skills through the theme Our Forests, using maps and investigations to understand where forests are found, why they are important and how people use and protect them.

Science: The children are learning about forces and their effects on objects.

RE: The children are considering the question Why do some people believe God exists?

PSHE: In Me and My Relationships, the children are learning about friendships, teamwork and emotions.

Art: The children are developing their drawing skills by creating portraits.

Music: The children are exploring melody and harmony.

PE: In gymnastics, the children are building their strength, balance and flexibility.

Computing: The children are learning about internet safety through All fun and games and are also working on Systems and searching.

Spanish: The children are learning how to describe family and friends.
