We have lots of learning to look forward to across KS2!

Year 3 and 4

In Maths this half term the children will be focusing on numbers to 1000 in Y3 and rounding and perimeter in Y4.

For our Writing, the children will be writing stories based on our class book 'The Lost Happy Endings'.

The children love science, and we are looking forward to teaching them all about skeletons this half term.

In geography, the children are learning about latitude and longitude on a map as well as taking a closer look at climate zones.

Understanding risks is really important, and we will be learning about this in PHSE.

With Miss Todd, the children will be rehearsing a new street dance in PE.

We are also looking forward to a trip to Hopetown this half term too!

Year 5 and 6

In our reading and writing this half term, the children are enjoying using the text, *The Secret Garden*.

Maths is focused on developing our use of number through multiplication and division in Y5, and fractions, decimals and percentages in Y6

During science this half term, the children are enjoying learning about earth and space.

PHSE and some of our computing work is focused on being safe in person and online - particularly during online chats.

During History, the children in Y5 & 6 are learning about a non-European society and this is focused on Baghdad 900AD.
