OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

Foundations for learning are so important to your children's education. As a result, these are a non-negotiable part of your children's offer every day.

C&L: Communication and language is part of every lesson every day.

Phonics and Reading: Y1 have daily Phonics lessons and keep-up sessions (where needed) on the same day. They also have reading practice sessions in small groups. Y2 children still access Phonics when needed and have specific Reading lessons.

Handwriting and Spelling: Handwriting takes place every day and this is also a focus in all subjects. Children have daily spelling lessons to teach them the key spelling rules.

Counting / No bonds / XT: Maths lessons are taught daily to all children with a focus on the key concepts. We also do Mastering Number four times per week to build up the children's number sense.

OUR WIDER LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

In **Science**, we will be looking plants and what types live around us. We will develop our **Geography** skills through fieldwork. Our **PSHE** lessons will focus on being kind. In **RE**, we will look at Christianity.
