OUR LEARNING THIS HALF TERM

For our **writing**, the children will be consolidating and securing their foundational skills before moving on to writing a setting description in Year 5 and using dialogue in Year 6.

In **Maths**, Year 5 will focus on decimal fractions, while Year 6 will explore numbers up to 10 million.

In **Science**, the children will learn about the circulatory system and how it works.

History will take us back to World War II, exploring its impact on Britain.

Through **PSHE**, pupils will develop problem-solving skills and practise being assertive.

In **RE**, we will consider ways to challenge racism and explore how religion can promote equality.

PE will focus on developing, refining and performing gymnastics skills.

In **Art**, the children will explore graphic art before designing and creating their own pieces.

Music lessons will investigate how technology has influenced and shaped music.

Computing will be focussing on communication online.
